**Dear Amici Dell'Istit. Sc. Elem. San Giorgio,**

I'm Sr Paula Tushabomwe, a social worker at St. Joseph Community Based Organization who is following Enock. I enjoy being a social worker because it exposes me to different people, making interactions, and socializing which is very interesting. Through my work, I learn to be gentle, kind, and friendly especially in the field. Additionally, I become more transparent, and open, ensuring inclusivity and feeling free with the beneficiaries.

This year I have been closely following up Enock and the family, through the various visits at school and at home. Health wise this year he has been fine, but I have always kept in touch with him to make sure he was good. Enock scholastically, is doing fine: he is now attending the first year of primary school at Marengoni day and boarding, Nursery and primary school.

With your precious help I also made several follow up visits, I have often interacted with Enock's teacher, who told me that he is a well behaved child, very committed with his studies and everyone is proud of him. Enock is very passionate about what is learned.

I like to spend my time with Enock and the family too! When I stay with Enock we chat about everything and I see how he is growing into a person who is open and cheerful. Enock has told me that he likes to playing with the friends during his free time.

I'm very grateful about your support because it has given me the possibility to know more Enock and to give all my help in facing the life challenges while I try to be attentive at his need of being loved and appreciated.

As you know Enock lives in the area of Nakaseke which is located in Central Uganda and is mainly home to the Baganda tribe. It is a rural area where houses are made with local materials like mud and iron sheet and wood. Many houses cultivate a little piece of land near the house, but the harvest is just enough for the daily survivals. In this area there is a high incidence of sicknesses as malaria, HIV/AIDS, typhoid and anaemia. The economic status of the family I follow is very poor, where quite a large number of our beneficiaries depend on farming as the source of income yet are challenged by the climate changes where at times they don't harvest anything at the end of the season leading the households to struggle a lot.

Enock's mother, Nalukwago Speranta, is working as a peasant farmer. The income is not yet enough to meet all the family's basic needs, but everyone is doing their best as possible.

I have been visiting their home several time this year and I found that their situation has improved. I always gives my advises to Nalukwago Speranta on how best handle the family situation and I always encourage them to take part to the project activities which we can implement through the funds you regularly send to us.

I'm very happy that in the past year I have been able to help this family in check on the academic performance, challenges encountered and build trust to help the child study well.

I'm very grateful about your presence and It's wonderful being together with you in this journey, while we accompany Enock and we spend time together and we interact. I personally get enriched by this relationship. I will continue following up Enock along a fulfilling path of growth.
